i will make this bold statement straight away this book finds big priced winners in uk handicap horse races easily and consistently i need to make a very important statement here backing double figure priced horses can return some huge profits but you must remember they all do not win more will lose races which is to be expected there is a reason why the horse is such a big price it is mainly due to the fact the horse has not won for a long time another reason is that a horse could be out of its depth in other words running in a higher class of race most punters want winners every day at any odds this makes them feel good they think they are making a profit how wrong they are and the bookmakers take their money every day with a smile on their faces another mistake the average punter makes is that they will take current sp starting price of a horse and not look for a larger price so say a horse is 2 1 that s decimal odds 3 0 on the betfair betting exchange they will readily take these odds a more profitable approach is to take higher odds like decimal odds 3 5 ok you might think there is not much difference between decimal odds 3 0 and 3

5 but it adds up over a year and that is where your profit is the only way to profit in horse racing is to back horses at larger odds than what is being offered the betting exchanges show the true odds of a horse just before the race starts as these odds are derived from many punters and bookmakers who are using the betting exchanges then the price of the horse before the race starts is its true odds this price is a consolidated view and it is normally correct and near the mark this system also finds large priced horses that are placed 1st 2nd 3rd or 4th regularly in a horse race and these can be exploited in the betfair place market at some juicy odds i have taken decimal odds of 7 0 on four places in a horse race and mopped up

this uk and irish handicap horse racing betting system contains 4 simple steps to identify potential winning horses in a horse race i wrote this system so that busy punters using the excellent racing post on the internet for free can find profitable horses quickly in handicap horse races i like this book because i have added some optional extra filters to the horse racing system to improve the quality of selections and to achieve a better strike rate i have written numerous books on horse racing but this is my favourite and most profitable uk and irish horse racing system

a statistical analysis of horse races deals with form course winners distance winners top jockeys ratings etc full of tables that show which form lines of a horse produce the most winners plus which show a profit loss taken from the results of 1374 races for win percentages and 566 races for profit loss the form of horses has been sorted in a unique way to give a different perspective on reading the form

introduction the title of this book is a bold statement and one cannot really state this unless you put your money where your mouth is i have written many books around uk horse racing systems and this one i really enjoyed due to the simplicity of this horse racing system and how easy it is to apply the system uses the excellent free racing post website where you can obtain all the form data you need to use this system plus you do not have to be a form expert to understand it i personally think horse racing pundits make heavy weather of horse racing form i e looking at a horse s breeding and many other factors i think this information just confuses the average punter i have added a special bonus horse laying system in this book and i think you will enjoy it this laying system is so easy to follow you will look back at all the bets you have placed in the past and wonder how did i get it so wrong yes it will hurt knowing how much money you lost when you should have not moving back onto the horse backing system picking winners will be very easy for you and even more you will gain confidence and control in your betting this horse racing system normally picks 2 to 3 horses per day in uk handicap horse racing markets you should aim at using betfair to place your bets due to the better prices and in play tactic i will show you in this book understand the system before placing bets i hope you enjoy it

visualising uk horse form uk horse racing system visualising uk horse form what exactly does that mean in a nutshell it s a way of reading uk horse form in a race very quickly without taking any notes you achieve this by only looking at valid key horse form pointers and thus not wasting time the more information you try to process for a horse on a race card the faster you get brain fatigue and then you make mistakes the book concentrates on uk all weather handicap horse races but you can use this visualisation technique on national hunt jumps or flat racing on the turf as well i have a preference for low grade all weather racing but that is my choice processing uk horse form data with your brain this is difficult as most punters cannot retain horse form data in their brain for too long some punters are better than others what am i talking about here analyse a uk racing post race card with 8 runners and assess the form of each horse without taking notes easy or not it is very hard because most punters look at the wrong uk form data and there is a problem with this approach they simply process too much irrelevant data and their brains cannot retain and process it in that precise moment they often switch between screens to cross reference facts etc this causes you to lose focus and forget the horse form you have just previously processed now do not get me wrong you will get better at doing this and retain data for longer when you look at the racing post race card you are trying to build a picture of the race that you are analysing during this visualisation process you must keep asking yourself why can that horse win this race what are the key horse form pointers that qualify this horse to win the race if you were laying a horse not to win a race you would reverse this process and ask yourself why the horse cannot win the race we will look at some examples later and it will become clearer

a quote i love horse racing betting systems i repeat this quote in many of my books sorry for being boring i have to cover this early in the book as i believe this is probably overlooked by most punters who continue to lose every day please look at the quote below and ponder on this for 5 minutes and ask yourself a question do you actually do this we are looking for a winner in a race not the winner of a race remember the above quote as most punters fail to understand this quote and this is why they lose money most punters look at the race cards looking for the winner of the race they should be looking for the winner in a race you have to be confident you have spotted a potential winner in a race not of a race you have to be prepared not to have a bet on days when there are no winners in a race remember this chapter it will serve you well non handicap horse races most of my uk horse racing system books have centered around uk handicap horse races this system focuses on non uk handicap races i will explain why i opted for these types of races in handicap races horses are allotted weight in relation to their ability so the best horses are allocated more weight so as to give the inferior horses in the race a chance of winning it is that simple weight is a leveller it slows horses down but it is not that simple as horses can be cleverly placed in races i won t say much more on this but i think you get the point in non handicap uk races it is easier to assess horse form as we do not have to worry about the weight allotted to a horse it s always difficult picking winners for handicap and non handicap races so we must not get complacent let us now look at this brilliant uk horse racing system

having spent 35 years of interest and involvement in british horse racing such as delving into form watching how different horses acted to different courses and goings alike using trainer and jockey statistics speed ratings etc i always felt like i couldn't paint a whole picture of how a race may pan out you would often hear a commentator say this newcomer will love the ground today being bred out of dubawi for example but i could never back this up with any data there was nothing in the racing publications other than who the horse was bred by no actual figures and for me and i'm sure i'm not alone in this i wanted to know which courses what going and distance combinations these horses would love and hate as well as being effective and non effective on cold hard evidence that said yes this will love today's conditions or stay well clear it loathes this i always thought if i had this information it would transform the way i would look at a race again so take this scenario you've seen a horse that has great form has won in this class distance was fine but had only run on good or softer ground and today was good to firm how do you know how it will fare chances are that based on the other factors alone this is a worthy fav and the odds are shortening all the time and it's won on good ground its likely to win but then your presented with the figures from all the sire's progeny that had tried these exact same conditions in the previous year which reads 19 runs 0 wins 1 place actual example figs how would you react now of course having this knowledge would drastically change your opinion of its favorite status and would be an invaluable resource to have so that was it i needed this information it was too important a factor not to have so this is where the idea of the stallion bible was born so what exactly is it well the stallion bible is a collection of data of each stallion's progeny to show their performance under various conditions for british racing for the purposes of this publication the focus is on uk racing not ireland during the flat turf season of 2017 to give us an up to date reference guide of how likely a horse running under the same conditions would fare during the 2018 flat campaign in order to have the information easily referenced and accessible the data has been broken down into different groups with the first two groups being 1 individual tracks courses of which there are 30 including both the july rowley courses at newmarket broken down by distance and going 9 230 entries 2 all distances goings combinations from the 30 courses combined from 5f 2m 5 5f 4 890 entries so for the above we have every horse that won or placed in 2017 shown within that stallion's

performance the third groups are based on race class so we have all the runners that won or placed shown by class 1 6 as well as the group performers groups 1 to 3 and all listed runners the next group is based on male or female or should i say colt gelding filly etc then we have a full list of all runners for each sire including 1 sire that has a perfect 4 runners 4 wins 4 places record and at the other end of the spectrum 3 sires that have a combined record of 154 runs 0 wins 19 places and the final 3 groups are the best and worst performing sires in terms of most profit to sp starting price most profit to bfsp betfair starting price lay bfsp there were 97 profitable sires to sp with one little known sire making a profit of 78 50 to a 1 stake or how about the top 2 sires to bfsp making a combined 1 226 26 to a 2 stake or how about laying there was 404 sires that would have been profitable laying all their runners and 223 sires that never managed 1 win between them 638 entries all in all this is a goldmine of information that can seriously help with your choosing or final analysis of a horse race with a detailed comparison of performance against key factors
